When we started scheduling meetings, I harbored a hope that we would be able to limit our travels to one year, but it only takes a little consideration of the large amount of support required to live in Santa Barbara to recognize that one year would not be enough. We are very happy, though, to be creeping closer to the 50% mark. We praise the Lord that our schedule has been full and we have recently been able to schedule meetings to fill our last openings through the Fall. In December, we plan to secure housing in Santa Barbara and have set aside some time for the move and to celebrate the holidays in our future home. We do have a few open services that we could schedule meetings for in November and December, so prayer would be appreciated as we try to reach out to a few churches in California. In January, we plan to take what we hope will be our final extensive deputation trip, working our way to Florida and back. It remains our prayer and tentative goal to begin holding services some time in the Spring.

We ended our previous letter in Ohio, and on Sunday, June 18, we had the joy of presenting in two churches that I have known and appreciated for years. Saturday, we had the opportunity to lead a teen boy to faith in Christ while out soul-winning with Bible-Way Missionary Baptist in Hamilton, OH.
